**After the application due date, applicants should allow for a minimum of two weeks for applications to be processed.

ADMISSION PROCESS AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. **The student must meet all College and University requirements.** For more details, please refer to each department's "Admission Materials Checklist" (available on the program's webpage) and the Graduate College website (<http://www.fau.edu/graduate>)
2. **The student must submit all primary materials (application, transcripts, GRE and other exam scores) to the Graduate College** (<http://www.fau.edu/graduate>)
3. **The student must have already obtained an M.Ed. in Counseling.**
4. The student must have a minimum grade point average of 3.5 for graduate study and 3.0 in the last 60 credits of undergraduate study prior to receiving the bachelor's degree.
5. The student must submit official Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores (no minimum sub score).
6. **The student must mail all supplementary materials to the Department of Counselor Education's mailing address.** Please refer to the "Admission Materials Checklist" for program requirements and mailing information, and/or contact the department for more details about specific application procedures and deadlines.
7. **All application materials must be received no later than the appropriate deadline listed above.** Only completed applications will be considered.
8. After applications are reviewed, select applicants will be scheduled for an interview with program faculty.
9. If admitted into the program, permission from a full-time faculty member is required for each course.
