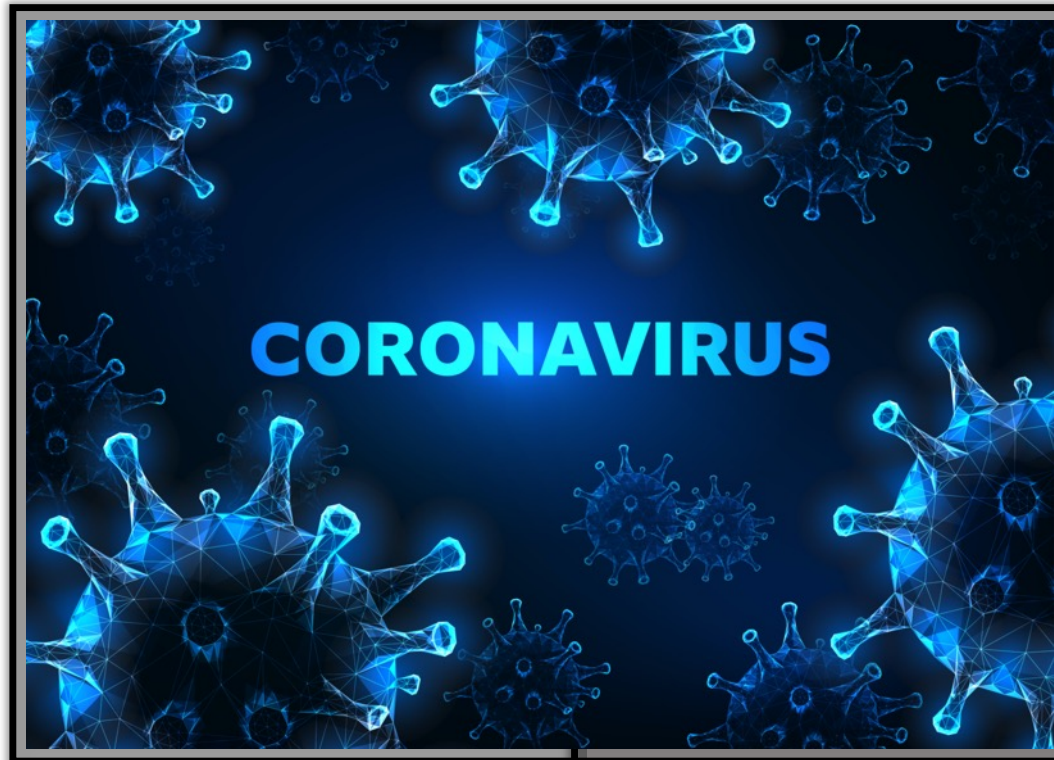


Coronavirus: New Normal

Now, we are able to go back to some of these places but some things might be different.



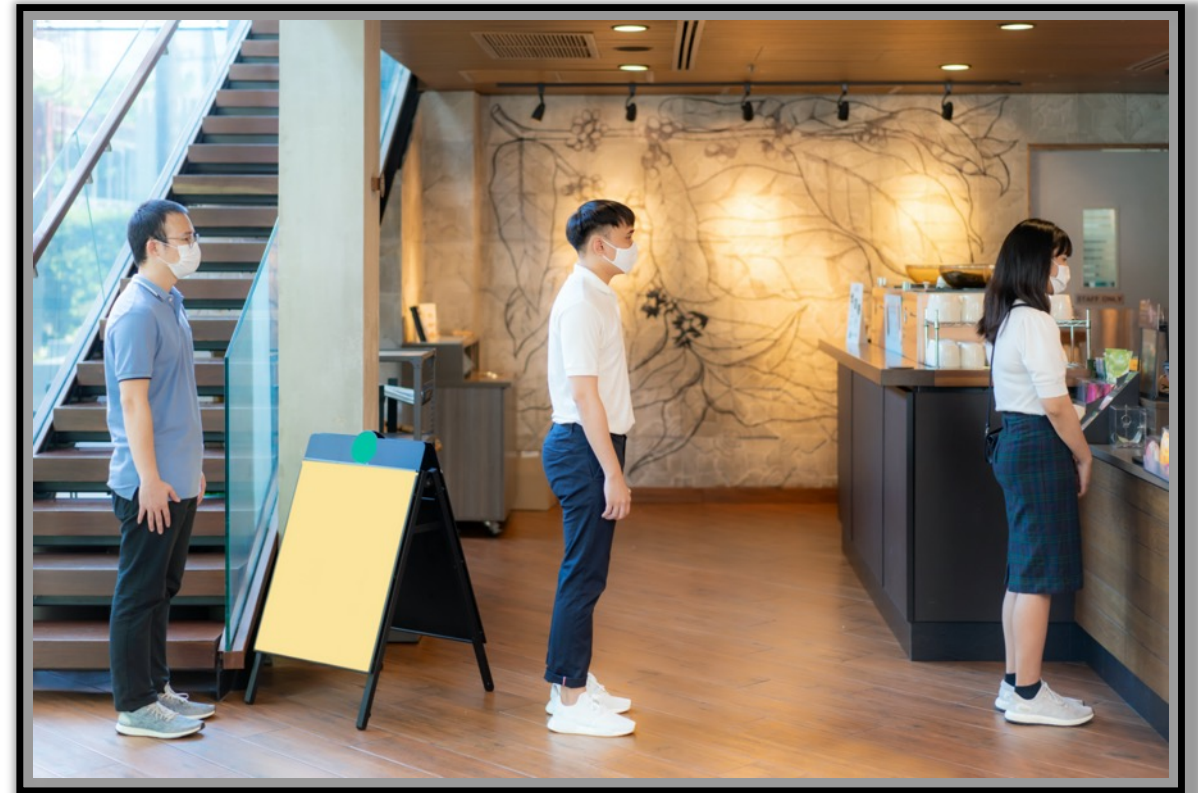


We might see people wearing face masks. We might have to wear a face mask too. Face masks help to stop the spread of viruses.



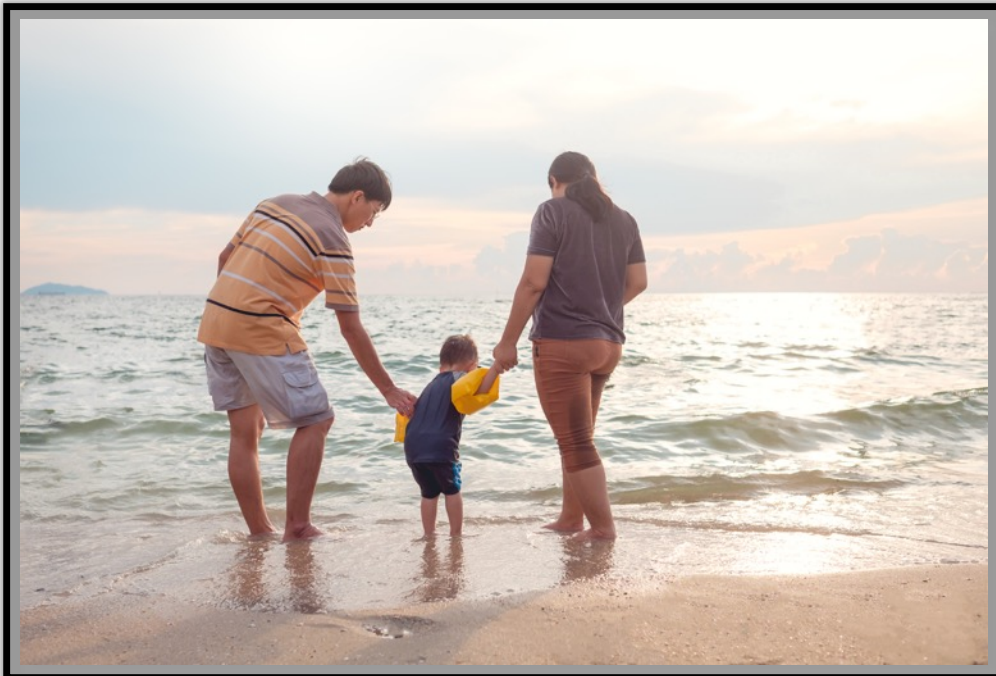


We might have to wait in line to enter a store. This is so we can stay a safe distance from each other.
