Biography

Jodi Leit is Core Teaching Instructor, Effective Teaching Practices, for the Department of Teaching and Learning in Florida Atlantic University (FAU)'s College of Education. She first worked for FAU as an Adjunct Instructor from 1996 to 1997. That same year and in 2006, Leit served as a University Supervisor for the College of Education. She was Field Placement Director for the Office of Academic and Students Services from 1997 to 2006 and became Core Teaching Instructor in 2006.

As a University Supervisor, Leit supervised both graduate and undergraduate Elementary Education majors during their full-time student teaching internship. As Field Placement Director, Leit created a field experience system that organized and coordinated field placements for more than 1,200 enrolled undergraduate and graduate students each semester in seven counties. She also created and implemented a computer data base for recording and tracking placements and security clearance of all field placements.

Presently, Leit teaches Effective Teaching Practices 1 to pre-professional students through hands-on activities relative to the real teaching profession. She serves as a Language Arts Resource Volunteer working with students at various elementary schools in Palm Beach County. Leit is a member of Kappa Delta Pi, the International Honor Society in Education.
