EXAMINATION: The Level I examination will be given on **Saturday, March 10** from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. at the FAU campus in Ft. Lauderdale. The examination fee for non-members is \$125.00 and \$180.00 for payment is received after February 24.
