



## EARLY ADMIT PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

### Advising and Registration

If you haven't already done so, have a current transcript sent to FAU's Office of Admission. Be sure to also include official transcripts of test scores or credits earned through AP/IB/CLEP exams, and High School Dual Enrollment classes.

Submit appropriate immunization information to FAU's Student Health Services Office. Their telephone number is (561) 297-0049. Holds will prevent you from registering for classes. Advising hold and orientation hold will be removed by early admission advisor.

You will register for courses on-line from MyFAU. The link is under Self Service. There is a video tutorial on OARS page that can help you. After registration, complete the Early Admission Authorization form and have your principal or designee sign the form. Mail or bring the form back for my signature. I will also process your tuition waiver. You are liable only for orientation fee, parking fee & student ID. I will email you the total amount.
