



EARLY ADMIT PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Early Admit Application Process

1. Complete Undergraduate/Freshman Application for Admission - indicate "Early Admission" where applicable on form and also include application fee. Application are available online at: http://www.fau.edu/admissions/Apply_Online.php
2. Along with your FAU application you also need to submit a completed "Supplemental Application" form. Go to <http://www.fau.edu/admissions/pdf/sup.pdf>
3. Submit to Admissions current high school transcript; also transcripts/scores of any high school dual enrollment courses taken, IB credits, AP scores, SAT-1 or ACT scores, etc. as required. Written permission from high school to allow FAU courses to satisfy any remaining requirements toward high school graduation.
4. Letters of recommendation attesting to the student's maturity and readiness to meet the academic and personal challenges posed by early entry into higher education are also required.
5. Tuition deposit of \$200 is not required for early admission students. You must however submit your acceptance to admission to FAU.
6. Upon receipt of acceptance to Early Admission Program, mail or fax FAU Immunization form <http://www.fau.edu/shs/additional/immunization.php> (with documentation) to FAU's Immunization Office.
7. After your acceptance to FAU, information regarding advising and registration process will be forwarded to the student from the Early Admissions advisor in the Freshman Academic Advising Office.

Advisement is handled through the Freshman Academic Advising Services office; failure to do so may result in the student being fee liable. The early admission program **does not include** orientation fee, photo ID, student fee (includes parking decal), textbooks (for some students) and any library fines or parking tickets incurred at FAU. Students are responsible for these costs.
