



EARLY ADMIT PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

EARLY ADMISSION CHECK LIST

To be accepted into the early admission program at FAU you must:

- ✓ have completed the equivalent of your junior year in high school (a minimum of six semesters) and require only one more year to complete all the requirements for a high school diploma;
- ✓ have proof of a SAT score of at least 1200 with a Verbal component score of no less than 440 and a Quantitative component score of no less than 440; if you will be submitting ACT test scores, you must have a 27 EACT with no less than 17 on the English component, 18 on the Reading component, and 19 on the Math component;
- ✓ have earned a 3.5 high school grade point average (as computed by the Office of Admissions)
- ✓ meet all the admission requirements for a regular degree-seeking student

In addition to official high school transcripts and SAT or ACT testing results, you must also submit the following documents:

- ✓ A completed application for admissions with a \$30.00 non-refundable application fee, Completed and signed by the student.
- ✓ A personal letter outlining your reasons for pursuing an early admission opportunity at Florida Atlantic University
- ✓ A signed statement of approval from your high school principal or guidance counselor.
- ✓ A completed "Supplemental Information for Early Admission" form (see the link below to download and print this form)
- ✓ If you are a home schooled student, you must submit an official copy of your letter of intent with your home school district approval and a completed "Supplemental Information for Early Admission" form (see the link below to download and print this form)
- ✓ A list of the courses that you need to graduate from your high school.
- ✓ To establish proof of Florida Residence, you must submit documentation concerning the parent or guardian's residency; this documentation includes: tax returns, letter of domicile, voter's registration card, Florida driver's license, and etc. Non-US Citizens must submit a photocopy of their Resident Alien cards (both sides).
- ✓ Proof of Measles Immunization and Health Form—This is required of all students attending FAU classes for the first time.

Course Information—Early Admission

1. Students enrolled in an early admission program must take courses that are creditable toward the high school diploma and the associate or baccalaureate degree at FAU.
2. To ensure transferability of credits, students and counselors may wish to concentrate on general education courses for students seeking Associate in Arts or baccalaureate degrees

3. College preparatory instructions, other forms of pre-collegiate instruction and physical education courses that focus on the execution of a skill rather than the intellectual attributes of the activity are not eligible for inclusion in the early admission program unless it is part of the degree program.

NOTE: The early admission program does not include the cost of student ID, parking decal, textbooks, library fine, medical clinic visits, and parking fines. The student will be held responsible for these costs.
