



EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Eligibility Requirements:

Students who have completed their junior year of high school may be considered for Early Admission. If accepted for Early Admission, the student enters FAU as a freshman instead of attending high school for the senior year.

Qualifications for consideration for Early Admission are:

- A 3.50 or better GPA (as calculated by FAU) after six semesters of high school;
- SAT score of 1800 or an ACT score of 27;
- Written permission from the high school to allow FAU courses to satisfy any remaining requirements toward high school graduation;
- Written recommendations from guidance counselor and teacher(s) attesting to the student's maturity and readiness to meet the academic and personal challenges posed by early entry into higher education;
- Must be a Florida resident.

Early Admission students must earn at least a "C" or better in each course and 2.0 or higher FAU semester GPA at the end of their Fall semester to continue in the program for Spring semester.

At the end of their freshman year, successful Early Admission students will have completed both their freshman year of college and graduation requirements for their senior year of high school.
