



EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

General Information

Excerpt from Florida Statutes 1007.27, Postsecondary Education--Articulated acceleration mechanisms:

Early admission shall be a form of dual enrollment through which eligible secondary students enroll in a postsecondary institution on a full-time basis in courses that are creditable toward the high school diploma and the associate or baccalaureate degree. Students enrolled pursuant to this subsection shall be exempt from the payment of registration, tuition, and laboratory fees.

The Early Admit Program enables qualified public, private and home-school students who have completed their junior year to enroll in approved academic courses offered through Florida Atlantic University. If accepted for Early Admission, the student enters FAU instead of attending high school for the senior year and will spend the Fall and Spring semesters full time at FAU. The credits that students earn count toward both a high school diploma and a college degree. Early Admit courses are free to students who attend a Florida public college or university; this includes registration, tuition and fees. Instructional materials (books) are provided to public school students free of charge through the School District of Palm Beach County and Broward County; however, students enrolled in home education programs or nonpublic secondary schools must provide their own instructional materials (books). They are eligible for tuition and fees.

Early Admit students are responsible for a transportation access fee, each semester (includes parking decal) and a photo ID Owl Card fee (first semester only). Fees are due by the end of the first week of classes. **The transportation access fee is a recurring charge and is charged to the student's FAU account every semester of enrollment.**

When enrolled in *Early Admit Program*, Students are allowed to register only for courses approved by their high school counselor and Early Admit advisor at Florida Atlantic University.

To continue in the dual enrollment program, students must earn a minimum grade of "C" (2.0 GPA) in each course they are registered for through the early admit program.
