



EARLY ADMISSION PROGRAM FOR FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

How much does it cost?

Tuition and matriculation fees are waived by the State of Florida for all Early Admit Program students. Early admit program waives tuition only for two semesters, generally Fall and Spring semester.

Students are responsible for the Transportation Access fee each semester and the one-time Owl Card fee.

Transportation Access fee:

Semester	Cost
Fall	\$64.90
Spring	\$64.90

Owl Card is a one-time fee of \$10.00 (first semester of enrollment). If you have already own an Owl card through dual enrollment program you do not have to purchase a new one.

Incoming students are required to attend freshman orientation. Students will register online for orientation at <http://www.fau.edu/orientation/> . Students are responsible for the orientation fee of \$75. For additional members it is \$50 each.

Instructional materials (books) are provided to public school students free of charge through the School District of Palm Beach County and Broward County; however, students enrolled in home education programs or nonpublic secondary schools must provide their own instructional materials.
