Scholarship

The FAU Greek GPA is not above the FAU Undergraduate GPA (2.66 vs. 2.80)

Alpha Nu Omega Fraternity & Sigma Phi Epsilon both achieved an Overall GPA above the Overall FAU undergraduate male GPA.

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the College Panhellenic community was 2.60

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the Interfraternity Council community was 2.41

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the Multicultural Greek Council was 3.06

The FAU Greek Membership Retention Rate is lower than the FAU Undergraduate Retention Rate (75% vs. 79%).
