The number of Greeks with a 3.0 gpa and above is the highest it's ever been since Fall 02! That means that more of you are setting educational goals and sticking by them, great job!

This semester's grade reports also list each member of your organization who is on probation, freshman warning, academic suspension and academic dismissal. Chapter and/or council officers in these situations please be aware that if this is your second consecutive term with a GPA under a 2.0 you are no longer eligible to hold office. All new member classes must strive to achieve at least a 2.5 GPA, not a 2.0 GPA! Assisting members with their academic achievement is central to each chapter's mission!

Those chapter members that did not complete the term, attended a different college, or did not have any hours for an average were listed on the individual chapter grade report, but may not have been averaged into the chapter's grade average.

Additionally, you may find that some chapter members were not on the grade report. While we may have overlooked them, chances are they did not appear on your updated list. You now have a thirty day (30) grace period to provide GPA's for missing persons and wrong/misspelled

names/social security number, the **deadline being January 29, 2004.** You will not however, be able to remove any members from your report.
