Executive Summary

Scholarship

- * The FAU fraternity & sorority community cumulative GPA is below the FAU undergraduate cumulative GPA (2.919) vs. (2.94).
- * The FAU fraternity & sorority community cumulative GPA increased .0063 points from Fall 2014 (2.856) to Spring 2015 (2.919).
- * The FAU sorority cumulative GPA increased .044 points from Fall 2014 (2.920) to Spring 2015 (2.964).
- * The FAU fraternity cumulative GPA increased 0.082 points from Fall 2014 (2.800) to Spring 2015 (2.882).
- *Three sororites (Alpha Nu Omega, Alpha Delta Pi, Sigma Lambda Gamma) had a cumulative GPA above the all-women's undegraduate cumulative GPA (3.01).
- *Nine (9) fraternities have a cumulative GPA above the all-men's undergraduate cumulative GPA (2.86).
- *The All-Panhellenic semester average (2.976) and cumulative average (2.968) were above the All-Undergraduate semester average (2.94) and cumulative average
- *The All-Interfraternity cumulative average (2.878) was above the All-Male cumulative average (2.86).
- *The All-Multicultural cumulative average (2.977) was above the All-Undergraduate cumulative average (2.94).

Membership

- *The FAU fraternity & sorority community had 493 students involved in fraternities and 857 students involved in sororities in Spring 2015.
- * The FAU fraternity & sorority community saw a total membership decrease of 4.2% from Fall 2014 (1409) to Spring 2015 (1350).
- *The FAU fraternity and sorority community saw a membership increase of 11.6% from Spring 2014 (1209) to Spring 2015 (1350).
- * The percentage of undergraduate students holding membership in fraternities/sororities was over 6% for Spring 2015.

Philanthopy & Service

- *The amount raised for philanthropy in Spring 2015 (\$55,689.54) increased by over 60% compared to Spring 2014 (\$35,790).
- *The amount raised in the 2013-2014 year (\$82,024) increased by over 33% compared to the 2014-2015 year (\$109,769.41).
- *The amount of service hours in Spring 2015 (3,340) increased by 61 hours compared to Spring 2014 (3,279).

Programming

*The Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life Programs included Standards of Excellence, Greek Week, Scholarship Banquet and Presidents Roundtables.
