### Field Experience Tour FAU Faculty-led Program Summer: May 5 – May 12, 2018

The Field Study in International Economics course is an instruction and tour program that studies production and allocation of resources in Costa Rica. The course focuses on business and economic development in Costa Rica. The course looks at the organizational frameworks related to resource allocation in Costa Rica, the role of the international economy (through the operation of multinational corporations and the conduct of international trade and finance), and the importance of cultural differences in business development and practices.

#### Eligibility and Requirements:

- Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher for undergraduate (sophomores, juniors, & seniors) and 3.0 or higher for graduate.
- Prerequisites: ECO 2013, ECO 2023, or ECO 3003.

#### Course Offerings:

- ECO 4955: Costa Rica Study Tour (3 credits)
- ECO 6958: Costa Rica Study Tour (3 credits)

#### Program Highlights:

- Lectures by educators & practitioners, transnational corporation & local firm tours.
- Visits to an active volcano, the free zone, and eco-tourism facilities.

**Application Deadline:** Thursday, February 15, 2018 (with \$100 administrative fee)

**Program Costs:** \$2,100 (for single occupancy accommodation). *Double occupancy may be an option if coordinated with another willing participant.*

**Program Cost Due Dates:** \$200 deposit - 1 week after application submission. (*Students will be notified of 1 week deadline after application processed*). \$1,840 - March 1. \$60 cash - April 14, 2018 collected at first program meeting.

#### Included:

- Airfare, hotel lodging, daily breakfast, 2 group lunches & dinners & FAU t-shirt.
- Local group transportation, group admission fees & CISI health insurance.

**Not Included:** FAU tuition (in state/out of state rates apply), \$100 administrative fee, most lunches/dinners and personal spending money.
