Andean Cultural Studies in Ecuador

Academic Program: Students will experience a Latin American country from “within” its culture through diverse activities ranging from traditional classroom lectures to experiential learning in a variety of non-traditional settings. Students will interact with local communities in three geographical areas of Ecuador: the coast, the Andes Mountains, and the Amazon Basin.

Eligibility Requirements: Program is open to undergraduate and graduate students with a 2.5 GPA or higher.

Course Descriptions:

Beginning/Intermediate (SPN 2952), or Advanced Spanish Conversation (SPN 4957) 3 Credit Hours: Intensive Spanish language and culture courses are offered through the Universidad de San Francisco en Quito. The student’s Spanish proficiency will be tested upon arrival. Course satisfies FAU foreign language requirement.

Andean Cultural Studies Course (SPT 3956) 3 Credit Hours: This Spanish culture course focuses on a wide range of topics from different disciplines, including history, archeology, anthropology, literary studies, art history, sociology, political science, and economics, drawing on local expertise from the host university and other sources.

*Directed Independent Study and Service-Learning Credits are available.

Program Fee: \$3,000.00

Program Fee Includes: Home stay accommodations (single/double), Hotel and Hostel accommodations (double), most meals, airfare Guayaquil to Quito, most transportation in-country, museum entrance fees, excursions, workshop materials, guest lectures, guides, application/administrative fee, International Student ID Card, basic insurance, pre-departure orientation, and on-site support staff. Applications should be submitted to the Office of International Programs; space is first come first serve.

Program Fee Does Not Include: Airfare, lunches while in Quito, FAU tuition (out of state tuition extra), books, and spending money.

Application Deadline: February 15, 2010 or as space permits.

Financial Aid: Students may be able to use their financial aid for study abroad. The amount of the financial aid awarded and its availability will be determined by the Office of Financial Aid. Students need to have a current FAFSA on file and complete a summer Financial Aid Application in order to apply for funding. Summer financial aid requires that students be registered for a total of 6 credits.
