Exchange Program University Jaume I Castelló, Spain

Castelló is the northernmost province in the Valencian Community. The town of Castelló de la Plana is 40 miles north of València and 177 miles south of Barcelona. Surrounded by beautiful mountains, Castellón is a seaside town on the Mediterranean Coast with a population of 120,000. It is located in the center of tourism and a thriving ceramics industry. Visitors can enjoy the local cuisine, including famous Valencia oranges and paellas.

Fall semester, or first semester, begins in September and ends in February. Spring semester, or second semester, begins in February and ends in July. It is recommended that you choose the second semester because the first semester will interfere with spring semester at FAU.

Student Program Services: The JAUME Office for International and Educational Cooperation (OCIE) hosts a reception and orientation for exchange students putting them in contact with their academic advisors, and includes meetings with UJI students, information sessions and outings (www.uji.es/serveis/otci). The Language and Terminology Service organizes specific courses for overseas students which are at beginner, intermediate and advanced levels. Additionally, the Self-Access Language Centre is specifically designed for learning, practicing and improving one's language skills (www.uji.es/serveis/slt).

Courses: Students can select coursework in all levels of Spanish and Spanish culture courses. At least one year of college level Spanish required. There is limited access to courses taught in English, with access to other disciplines taught in Spanish.

Living Accommodations: Students have a wide range of accommodations to choose from, please visit: www.uji.es/UK/content/inst/634059-634176.html#2

- **The Campus University Residence:** Located on campus, this option is most suitable for students staying for one year, but rooms may be booked for a semester (est. 440 Euros per month).
- **Residencia Domus Maria:** This residence is located near the town center and is well linked to campus by municipal bus service.
- **Student Apartments and Flats:** INFOCAMPUS at the University offers information about rooms and flats for rent, flat-sharing and residences through the Accommodation Directory.
- **Homestay:** Families that are willing to host students during the semester may be located through OCIE (est. 400 Euros per month includes ½ board).

Program Costs: FAU tuition (in-state/out-of-state rates apply), airfare, FAU application fee/basic insurance/ISIC card (\$100), admission fee (est. \$84), books, overseas living and personal expenses.

Deadlines for Applying: March 15, 2009 (fall semester); October 1, 2009 (spring semester). FAU students must be nominated by the Office of International Programs to participate in the UJI program.
