The capital of Portugal since its conquest from the Moors in 1147, Lisbon is a legendary city with over 20 centuries of History. Lisbon traverses the ages - From the 12th century Se Cathedral to the modern bridges spanning the Tagus River, from the 18th century Aguas Livres Aqueduct to the futuristic Oriental Station.

Program Fee Does Not Include: Airfare, most meals, spending money, and FAU tuition if financial aid is needed.

Application Deadline: Applications will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. Early applications are advised as there are a limited number of places available for each program.
