Silla University

Busan, South Korea

Silla University is located in Busan (Pusan), Korea's second largest city with close to 4 million people. It also serves as the country's main port for international cargo, as well as passenger ferries to Japan and Jeju Island. The city is famous for its seafood and beaches, as well as the Hallyosudo Waterway with its picturesque islands. About 500 foreign students from all over the world study at Silla University each year. To learn more about Silla University, visit www.silla.ac.kr/eng/index.php

Spring semester, or first semester, begins in early March and ends in late June. Fall semester, or second semester, begins in late August and ends in mid December.

Student Program Services: Silla's Korean Language Education Center offers courses for overseas students which are run at beginner, intermediate and advanced levels. Small classes consisting of about 15 students provide individualized instruction. Educational facilities include audio and visual labs featuring large screens. Extra-curricular activities are offered including theatre, sports, music and movies.

Courses: All courses have a Korean focus, they include, Culture and Language, History, Political Science, Popular Culture, Business, Dance, Modern Movies & Culture, and Women's Studies. A limited number of courses are taught in English each semester. Students register for 12 credits composed of 6 classes. All courses transfer back as elective credit.

Living Accommodations: Double occupancy dorm room with private bathroom.

Program Costs: Students pay FAU tuition (\$1,735 in state/\$7,073 out of state), some living and travel expenses. Silla University pays for double occupancy housing, half of airfare (reimbursed upon arrival); or full airfare if attending for one year, Busan airport transfers to and from Silla University, and cultural activities.

Estimated Costs: Airfare (\$1,100-1,500), FAU application fee/basic insurance/ISIC card (\$100), meals (3 per day KRW 216,000), personal travel, books, Korean insurance (\$130), and spending money. Exchange rates fluctuate daily. Visit www.oanda.com for the current exchange rate.

Deadlines for Applying: December 15th for spring, and June 15th for fall
