Venice (Italian: *Venezia*, Venetian: *Venezsia*, Latin: *Venetia*): Venice's nicknames include "Queen of the Adriatic", "City of Water", "City of Bridges", and "The City of Light." Spend your summer experiencing and living *La Dolce Vita* in one of Italy's most famous cities. Tour some of the world's most treasured sites outside of the tourist's routes. Planned excursions include the Venetian Villas along the Brenta Canal by boat, the Dolomiti Mountains with a nature walk, and a boat tour of the Venetian lagoon. This program provides students with the opportunity to learn Italian language and culture through full immersion while discovering the geography, monuments and artwork the city offers. Studying in Venice gives students a sensation of living in a place out of this world- no streets, no cars, no noise, only footsteps and water reflections in every corner.

Eligibility Requirements: Program is open to undergraduate and graduate students with a 2.5 GPA or higher.

Courses (students must take two courses):

A course may be cancelled due to low enrollment.

Program Fee: \$2,800

Program Fee Includes: Housing (apartment-double occupancy), three group excursions (the Venetian Villas along the Brenta Canal by boat, the Dolomiti Mountains with a nature walk, and a boat tour of the Venetian lagoon) and associated transportation and meals, three additional group meals, museum visits, pre-departure orientation, CISI health insurance, on-site support orientation, and on-site support staff.

Program Fee Does Not Include: Airfare, FAU tuition (out-of-state tuition extra), most meals, books, \$50 refundable housing damage deposit and spending money.

Application Deadline: February 15, 2012 or as space permits.

Financial Aid: Students may be able to use their financial aid for study abroad. The amount of the financial aid awarded and its availability will be determined by the Office of Financial Aid. Students need to have a current FAFSA on file and complete a summer Financial Aid Application in order to apply for funding.
