College of Architecture, Urban, and Public Affairs

The Social Work and Urban & Regional Planning degree programs require a course-bycourse evaluation with GPA calculation.

All other programs require a general evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.

College of Arts & Letters

All degree programs require a general evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.

College of Biomedical Science

The Master's degree in Biomedical Science requires a course-by-course evaluation with GPA calculation.

College of Business

All programs require a course by course evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.

College of Education

Educational Leadership requires a general evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.

All other programs require a course-by-course evaluation with GPA calculation.

College of Engineering

All degree programs require a general evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.

College of Nursing

All degree programs require a course by course evaluation with GPA calculation.

College of Science

Geology and Integrative Biology require course-by-course evaluations with GPA calculation.

All other programs require a general evaluation; GPA calculation is not necessary.
