- **IV.** Nancy Condemi confirmed all the appropriate changes were made.
- **V.** The above curriculum items were approved unanimously to move forward to the Steering meeting on February 14th.
- VI. Graduate College Interim Dean's Report:
 - a. Dr. Sobhan announced the following:
 - i. The signed gift agreement for the 3MT championship award was a \$100,000 endowment
 - ii. Raising the average for graduate student worker stipends was well received by the Provost after Dr. Sobhan presented the numbers.
 - 1. The average stipend and health insurance coverage numbers were evaluated based on comparisons with other SUS schools.
 - b. The colleges were sent an email asking what the anticipated number of GTA/GRAs are for 2019-2020 and has a deadline of February 22nd to return his information.
 - c. There are currently 853 enrolled/active doctoral students.
 - i. This is a 3% growth from last year.
 - ii. Dr. Sobhan proposed that every meeting, there should be announcements and/or questions from the Director of Graduate and Professional Student Association (GPSA) in which the Director agreed.
- **VII.** Hannah Baker spoke on the following:
 - a. There is travel funding left in the budget for the 2018-2019 academic year to support students.
 - i. She encouraged the council to let their students know and to contact gpsa@fau.edu for any assistance needed.
 - b. Graduate Student Research Day is coming up April 5th
 - i. In need of judges
 - c. This will be her last semester as Director.
 - d. There are 4 open student positions in their department. These are not eligible to students who have full time tuition waivers.
- **VIII.** Dawn Frood spoke on the Library's Open Evaluation resources (OER).
 - a. She can set up colleges with a liaison in the Library to assist in library resources, which could potentially bringing down textbook prices.
 - b. Ken Dawson Scully noted that at the Steering meeting they are looking at keeping textbook costs down to \$30/credit hour,
 - c. Adam Bradford invited Dawn Frood to share this information or speak about the Library's resources at the College of Arts and Letters.
