Discussion of the Revision of Thesis and Dissertation Guidelines Angela Lints explained changes:

Summer students can use either the original or revised form. Guidelines should be revised every year. Question; one member asked about what other schools do with electronic signature page. One member suggested that there should be no heading on the dedication page. The appendix should have a margin. There should be a plagiarism check. Consistency is important.

Discussion of Graduate Faculty

Lists of Graduate Faculty are updated three times a year. These lists are sent to all departments to be audited and certified and then sent back to the Graduate College. On the fifth year, lists are sent about renewals. Individual colleges have their own graduate document to renew. Form 1 not necessary for renewal, only for new appointments.
