- ✓ Application status: Once your application has been submitted, you can check your application status online to ensure transcripts and test scores have been received.
- Residency classification: Your residency classification automatically defaults to non-Florida. After you are admitted, the residency officer will request additional documents by email if needed.

Domestic Students

- Bachelor's degree
- Overall Undergraduate GPA of 3.0; if less than 3.0 GPA, you must take the GRE and submit scores
- Personal Statement (750-1000 words)
- Current Resume
- Two (2) letters of recommendation: one letter from a professor from a school you attended (preferred) and must address the applicant's ability to succeed at graduate-level academic work in nonprofit management

International Students

- Bachelor's degree
- Overall Undergraduate GPA of 3.0; if less than 3.0 GPA, you must take the GRE and submit scores
- Personal Statement (750-1000 words)
- Current Resume
- Two (2) letters of recommendation: one letter from a professor from a school you attended (preferred) and must address the applicant's ability to succeed at graduate-level academic work in nonprofit management
- Writing sample (500 words)
- A general evaluation of international transcripts is required; FAU will do the evaluation internally or it must be done by a NACES member
- TOEFL score of 550 or IBT of 61; IELTS 6.0; Duolingo 90
