- Official Transcripts: Official Transcripts and/or Official Foreign Credential Evaluations must  $\checkmark$ be received from each college or university attended. For more information on how to send transcripts, please visit our website: fau.edu/graduate/apply.
- Supporting documentation: Supplemental documents should be uploaded as separate files  $\checkmark$ as part of the online graduate application. NOTE: You will not be able to submit your application until all the supplemental materials are uploaded.
- **Conduct:** A "yes" answer to either of the conduct questions on the online application will  $\checkmark$ require a written explanation. Additional information may be requested when your application is under review. Applications will not be fully processed until all conduct issues are cleared.
- Application status: Once your application has been submitted, you can check your  $\checkmark$ application status online to ensure transcripts and test scores have been received.
- Residency classification: Your residency classification automatically defaults to non-Florida.  $\checkmark$ After you are admitted, the residency officer will request additional documents by email if needed.
