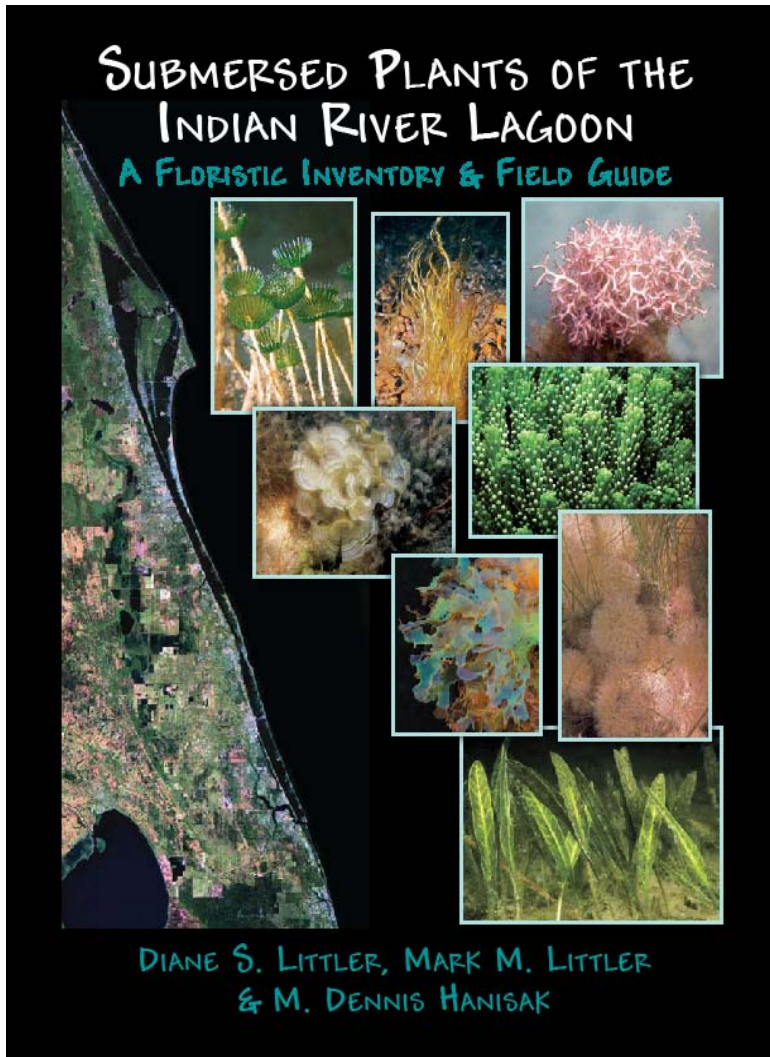

The species richness and biochemical/physiological diversity of marine plant life are unequalled in the biological world. This field guide provides critically needed baseline inventories to resource managers, conservationists and the broad scientific community, and serves as an educational/recreational guide for the interested public, who now have a usable means to accurately identify the organisms that form the basis of the marine food web.
