In 1984, FAU admitted its charter freshman class, becoming a four-year institution. By 2006, enrollment university-wide had grown to more than 25,000. Full-time students account for 52% of the total enrollment. FAU enrolled 2,314 first-time-college students for fall 2006. Enrolled students represent 143 countries and 48 states plus the District of Columbia..
