Florida Atlantic University, the fifth public university in Florida, opened its doors in 1964 with an enrollment of 867 upperdivision and graduate students. In 1984, FAU admitted its charter freshman class, becoming a four-year institution. By 2007, enrollment university-wide had grown to more than 26,000. Full-time students account for 55% of the total enrollment. FAU enrolled 2,676 first-time-college students for fall 2007. Students are enrolled from 137 different countries and 47 states plus the District of Columbia.
