Florida Atlantic University, the fifth public university in Florida, opened its doors in 1964 with an enrollment of 867 upper-division and graduate students. In 1984, FAU admitted its charter freshman class, becoming a four-year institution. By 2008, enrollment university-wide had grown to more than 26,000. Full-time students account for 52% of the total enrollment. FAU enrolled 2,800 first-time-college students for fall 2008. Students are enrolled from 139 different countries and 48 states plus the District of Columbia.
