

We offer non-credit courses and one-time lectures, events and performances in a welcoming atmosphere in our state of the art facility - the Barry and Florence Friedberg Auditorium. Thus far, in 2010, we've had over 22,000 registrations for our various programs.

More than 7,500 students register annually for Lifelong Learning classes on the Jupiter Campus. The program began on the Northern campuses in 1997 with 125 registrations. Thirteen years later LLS offers over 80 classes and is housed in their own \$6,000,000 complex.
