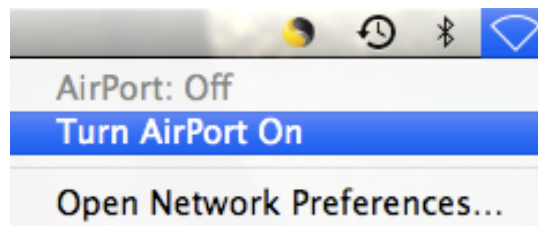


FAU Wireless Configuration for Mac OS X v10.5 Leopard

Note: If you have Airport turned ON, skip Step 1.

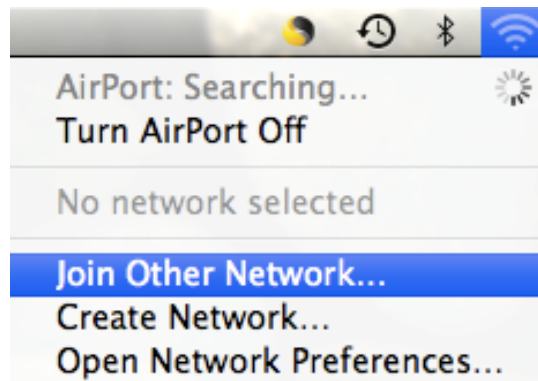
Step 1

- To turn Airport ON, click on the Airport icon and select "Turn Airport On"




Step 2

- Click on the Airport icon and select "Join Other Network..."



Step 3

- Type in "fau" as the "Network Name:"
- Select None as the option for "Security:"
- Check "Remember this Network" and click on "Join".



Enter the name of the network.

Enter the name of the network you want to join, and then enter the password if necessary. You can also click Show Networks to see a list of available networks.


