A "Master Playwright Event," presented by Palm Beach Dramaworks will be featured on Tuesday, February 21, 2012. This free event is a community engagement collaboration of the Harriet L. Wilkes Honors College and Palm Beach Dramaworks.

A presentation of the life, work and influence of a man who, in addition to being one of history's greatest playwrights, was a physician, prison reformer and one of the leading short story writers of his time. The evening will include readings by professional actors from Chekhov's "The Seagull," "The Cherry Orchard" and an adaptation of one of his most famous short stories, "The Huntsman."

The Master Playwright Series was developed in 2007 as part of Dramaworks' educational initiative. This event features Mark Perlberg presenting an overview of the playwright's life and work, with scene readings by professional actors. In addition to the readings, the audience is invited to discuss the work and themes.

Palm Beach Dramaworks is a non-profit, professional theatre and is a member of the Theatre Communications Group, the South Florida Theatre League, Florida Professional Theatres Association, Florida Theatre Conference, and the Palm Beach County Cultural Council.
