OWL of the Year Award: Awarded to one student from each of the Northern Campuses who has shown academic excellence, a commitment to university and community leadership and meets the following criteria:

3.0 overall FAU GPA or higher

Enrolled in 9+ credit hours within Summer 2010, Fall 2010 and Spring 2011

Volunteer of the Year Award: Awarded to one student who continually and altruistically volunteers in the community and/or university and meets the following criteria:

In good standing with FAU

Registered FAU student in both Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 semesters

Rising Star Award: Awarded to one student who has demonstrated leadership, dedication and service to the Northern Campuses, exhibits potential for greater leadership excellence and meets the following criteria:

3.0 overall FAU GPA or higher

Enrolled in 9+ credit hours within Summer 2010, Fall 2010 and Spring 2011

Has attended 3 or fewer semesters on the Northern Campuses

Outstanding Student Awards: One from each college

- Design & Social Inquiry

- Science

Awarded to one student from EACH college and EACH Northern Campus who has shown academic excellence and meets the following criteria:

3.5 or higher overall FAU GPA within major.

Demonstrated involvement within campus community.

Enrolled in 9+ credit hours within Summer 2010, Fall 2010, and Spring 2011.

Exceptional Faculty Awards: One from each college

- Arts & Letters
- Business
- Design & Social Inquiry
- Education
- Honors
- Science

Awarded to one faculty member from EACH college and EACH Northern Campus who continually motivates students to excel and creates an environment enabling students to surpass their own expectations.

Staff of the Year Award: Awarded to one staff member on the Northern Campuses who has continually gone beyond the call of duty to assist students and make a positive difference on campus. This staff member should have been employed for at least 6 months.

Club of the Year Award: Awarded to the club who actively involved the student body and seeks to enhance campus life and meets the following criteria:

A registered club with the Office of Student Involvement in good standing all year

Demonstrated campus contributions to student life on campus

Club Advisor of the Year: Awarded to the club advisor who has graciously donated his/her time to advise one of the campus clubs, helping the group achieve their mission.

Unsung Hero/Heroine: Awarded to one student and one faculty/staff member whose significant contributions to the university often go unrecognized.
