Year 1: Fall

- Introduction to Office of Undergraduate Research & Inquiry (OURI) & Prestigious Fellowships
 - Schedule an appointment (virtually or in-person) through Navigate Success
 - To learn more about <u>OURI and undergraduate research</u>
 - To learn more about <u>Prestigious Fellowships</u> and complete <u>Intake Form</u>
- Attend one <u>OURI workshop</u> and/or join the <u>Prestigious Fellowships Canvas Course</u>
- Identify a faculty mentor and begin conversations with the mentor to include Directed Independent Research (DIR) and other research course opportunities for the Spring semester
- Complete <u>CITI training</u> Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) modules and other research training as discussed with your faculty mentor

Year 1: Spring

- Meet with faculty mentor and begin working on research project
- Collaborate with faculty mentor to apply for an OURI <u>Undergraduate Research Grant</u> or the <u>FAU WAVE</u> <u>Competition</u>.
- Attend (or present) at the OURI Undergraduate Research Symposium in Spring
- Strongly recommended to participate in <u>Prestigious Fellowships How to Apply workshop series</u>
- Apply for an internal/external summer research experience for undergraduates
 - o OURI <u>Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship</u> (Faculty mentor applies)
 - o <u>NSF Research Experience for Undergraduates</u>
 - o Other research funding opportunities
 - o Other Prestigious Fellowship opportunities

Year 1: Summer

• Strongly recommended and with the support of your academic advisor: Continue working with faculty mentor in research and/or participate in a summer research experience inside or outside of FAU.

Year 2:

- Continue working with faculty mentor in research
- Identify and apply for Prestigious Fellowship opportunities
 - <u>Barry Goldwater Scholarship:</u> STEM sophomores/juniors planning to go to PhD or MD/PhD programs
- If you are a student on the Boca campus, apply for Honors in the Major Programs
- Present your research at a regional or national conference (consult with your faculty mentor)
 - o <u>Undergraduate Research Symposium</u> in Spring
 - o Life Sciences South Florida (LSSF)- Regional and STEM-focused
 - o Florida Undergraduate Research Conference (FURC)- Statewide
 - o <u>National Conference on Undergraduate Research (NCUR)</u>- National

Years 3 and 4:

- Apply for an external summer research experience for undergraduates
 - o <u>NSF Research Experience for Undergraduates</u>
 - Other <u>research funding opportunities</u>
- Identify and apply for Prestigious Fellowship opportunities
 - o <u>Barry Goldwater Scholarship</u>: STEM sophomores/juniors planning to go to PhD or MD/PhD programs
 - <u>NSF GRFP</u> STEM graduate scholarships for research-focused graduate students (Seniors eligible)
