



Peace Studies Joan Joseph Foundation Scholarship

The Peace Studies Joan Joseph Foundation Scholarship offers a scholarship for Fall 2011 of \$500 to a student whose work demonstrates support and continuous interest in the area of peace studies.

The applicants must submit a letter of recommendation and a 500 word essay or poem expressing a vision for world peace and/or the advancement of global human rights. In addition, the applicants need to include an unofficial transcript, and a brief description how they consider funding can assist their work.

In order to be considered for the Peace Studies Joan Joseph Foundation Scholarship, the applicants need also to demonstrate peace and/or humanitarian efforts by explaining participation in related activities during high school and/or college, stating the academic year in which they occurred.

The applicants have to be Palm Beach residents; enrolled in at least nine (9) hours, with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Preference will be given to undergraduate students, although proposals from graduate students will also be considered.

The successful applicant(s) will be expected to offer a public presentation of their work to FAU faculty, staff and student community as well as community at large interested to support Peace Studies Program mission.
