It is comprised of Mr. Eric Alexander's personal gift endowment and support from the State of Florida's matching program. The Eric Alexander Computer Science Scholarship Award is a part of the TOP Scholars Program (Treasure Coast Campus Opportunities for Professional Development) which recognizes outstanding academic achievement by providing financial assistance to students attending the Treasure Coast Campus of Florida Atlantic University.

Florida Atlantic University is working to build a strong tradition of tuition assistance programs. This scholarship program is focused on advancing our Engineering programs on the Treasure Coast Campus. It will provide many opportunities to deserving students and will leave a lasting legacy on campus for future generations.

**CRITERIA**

---

- Applicants must be part-time or full-time students enrolled or accepted to be enrolled at FAU with a declared major in Geomatics Engineering, which is headquartered at the Treasure Coast Campus.
- Applicants must demonstrate academic progress towards a degree having completed 30 or more credit hours accepted by FAU with a minimum 2.8 GPA.
- A personal statement detailing your Career Goals in Geomatics Engineering must accompany the application (not to exceed 500 words).
- An unofficial transcript must accompany the application (can be downloaded at [www.facts.org](http://www.facts.org)).
- **Past-recipients** are eligible to receive the scholarship again if they have maintained or exceeded a 3.0 GPA depending upon funding.
- The scholarship will be an award of \$400 per recipient, per semester, applied to the recipient's institutional tuition and fees.
- If you are offered a scholarship and cannot enroll, you are required to notify FAU in writing. Failure to notify the university could affect your eligibility for future awards.
