The Florida Institute of Certified Public Accountants- Sailfish Chapter Scholarship Award was established to assist accounting students attending the Treasure Coast Campus of Florida Atlantic University. The FICP-Sailfish Scholarship is a part of the TOP Scholars Program (Treasure Coast Campus Opportunities for Professional Development) which recognizes outstanding academic achievement by providing financial assistance to students attending the Treasure Coast Campus of Florida Atlantic University. Funding for the scholarship is through the FAU Foundation, Inc.

Florida Atlantic University is working to build a strong tradition of tuition assistance programs. This scholarship program is focused on advancing our Accounting program on the Treasure Coast Campus. It will provide many opportunities to deserving students and will leave a lasting legacy on campus for future generations.

**CRITERIA**

---

- Applicants must be part-time or full-time admitted degree seeking students and have completed 69 credit hours or more as accepted by FAU (6 or more credits must be FAU Accounting courses) **FALL 2009 GRADES WILL BE INCLUDED FOR EVALUATION ONCE POSTED.**
- Applicants must have a declared undergraduate major in Accounting with demonstrated progress towards a degree in accounting with a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- Applicants must be Florida residents of Indian River, Martin , or St. Lucie County.
- A personal statement detailing career goals not to exceed 300 words is required.
- An unofficial transcript must accompany the application (can be downloaded at [www.facts.org](http://www.facts.org) or MYFAU).
- **Past-recipients** are eligible to apply for the scholarship again if they have maintained or exceeded a 3.0 GPA. Past-recipients must repeat the entire application process every semester.
- The scholarship will be awarded in units of \$300 with a maximum of 5 units per recipient in an award year. It will be applied to the recipient's institutional tuition and fees. The availability of funding is determined by the FAU Foundation and is subject to change.
- If you are offered a scholarship and can not enroll, you are required to notify FAU in writing before December 18, 2009. Failure to notify the university could affect your eligibility for future awards.
