Please read the following information in regards to your Spring 2010 schedule.

- ◆ I understand that I am responsible for checking for and removing all registration holds prior to 8am on **Monday, November 16th**. If I have a hold when the CLASS team attempts to register me on November 16th, I will not be registered for any of the selected courses for the LC by that office. I will then be responsible for registering myself for all of my own courses and space will not be reserved for me in the courses I had selected.
- ◆ I understand that this schedule is a general suggestion for my major and Learning Community. It will not meet all students' required courses. I must schedule an advising meeting with my Freshman Academic Advisor. It is my responsibility to make sure that all courses I register for are appropriate for my major.
- ◆ If I have already met with my advisor and there are courses that I would like to take on the LC registration form that differ from the previously approved courses, I understand that I **MUST** get approval from my advisor prior to selecting courses with the LC.
- ◆ I understand that if I register myself for Spring 2010 course(es) that conflict with the LC courses that I selected, the CLASS team will not be able to register me for those LC courses that conflict.
- ◆ I understand that I am responsible for ensuring that the courses I am self-registering for do not conflict with the LC courses I am selecting.
- ◆ I have made a copy of this schedule for my records so I know what CLASS will register me for and I will know what I need to register for on my own.

***** Please Note the Important Information Listed Below *****

- ◆ *If you will be taking a math course, you must have either taken a math course this fall or take the ALEKS Math Placement Test (www.fau.edu/mathplacement). Please see your Freshman Academic Advisor to confirm which math course is appropriate for your major and your skill level.
- ◆ *If you are selecting a course that has a prerequisite course (ie ENC 1102, CHM 2046, etc), you must successfully complete the prerequisite course this fall. If you do not successfully complete the prerequisite course, you will be required to drop yourself from the selected course in the spring.
