The Undergraduate Program Committee and the Faculty Assembly of the Christine E. Lynn College of Nursing have passed a new grade point average (GPA) for admission into the RN-BSN track of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Program.

The current GPA is 2.75; the new admission GPA for the RN-BSN track of the BSN program is 2.5.

Rationale: The RN-BSN student has already successfully completed an Associate of Science in Nursing degree and is a licensed Registered Nurse (RN). These nurses want to earn the BSN degree for career advancement. The 2.5 GPA will increase enrollment in the RN-BSN track, align College of Nursing Transfer admission criteria with other FAU transfer admission GPA Criteria, and respond to the Future of Nursing recommendation to increase the percentage of RNs prepared at the BSN level.
