COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

For Students, Faculty, & Staff of Non-student organizations (Student Organizations – Please refer to “Competition Guidebook for Student Organizations” for a complete list of rules and regulations)

extravaCANza is a fun, charitable canned food drive competition taking place during Homecoming week at FAU. Participating teams collect canned goods to build a sculpture during “extravaCANza”.

The **2009 theme** for extravaCANza is “Past, present, and future of FAU.”

The event is open to all faculty, staff, and students of non-student organizations.

- ❖ Takes place Tuesday, October 27, 2009 in the Student Union
- ❖ Construction will last from 10am – 11:30am. These times are strict!
- ❖ All canned goods/non-perishables will be donated to Boca Helping Hands

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

For Students, Faculty, & Staff of non-student organizations

1. Any team whose members are deemed by the Committee to be acting in an unprofessional manner, including but not limited to: disorderly conduct, vandalism, theft, unauthorized entry, verbal or physical threats; will automatically be disqualified.
2. All teams must designate a “team captain” to serve as the official contact for your team until the event is over. This person will be the liaison between your team and the extravaCANza Committee.
3. Each competing team member must check in at the Team Check-in Table prior to the event. Only those students listed on the Team Roster will be able to participate.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams that are not student organizations.
5. **Competition Sign Up Procedure: Deadline for Application** for Students, Faculty, & Staff of non-student organizations is **Friday, October 16, 2009, at 5:00pm** in the Weppner Center for Civic Engagement and Service located in Student Support, Building 8, room 222L.
6. Competition winners for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place will be announced during half-time at the Homecoming football game on Saturday, October 31st.

“extravaCANza” Competition Contest Guidelines

Event Date: Tuesday, October 27th, 2009

Each team will build a sculpture out of canned goods for this competition. Your organization will bring in canned goods on Tuesday, October 27th, and be given 1 ½ hours to build a sculpture out of these canned goods that incorporates the theme of Homecoming: Past, Present, & Future of FAU. Examples of sculptures might include a football stadium, an FAU owl, football posts, etc. This is your time to get creative and see what you can design out of canned goods!

extravaCANza Contest Guidelines:

- Teams can check-in at the Check-in table in the Student Union between 9:00 am- 9:45am
 - * **Note:** The earliest you can bring your canned goods in to the Student Union is 8:30 am!
- At the check-in table, each team will complete a registration sheet listing the team members present and the number of canned goods donated (this number is subject to verification by the Committee)
- Teams are allowed to leave and buy canned goods during the event.
- Each team will be given an assigned space in the Student Union and can begin building at 10:00am and must stop at 11:30am.
- Judging of the sculptures will begin at 11:30am by a panel of students, faculty, and staff.
- Winners will be identified on Tuesday, October 27th. Competition winners from each category will be announced during half-time at the Homecoming football game on Saturday, October 31st.
- No canned goods may be painted, glued, or their labels removed or covered in any way.
- Canned goods can actually be any non-perishable item (including canned fruits and vegetables, boxes of pasta, pudding, pancake batter, oatmeal, macaroni and cheese, instant potatoes, crackers, etc.)
- 75% of the sculpture has to be cans, and 25% can be decorations and props.

Scoring:

- Sculptures will be judged based on creativity and FAU spirit, including how the sculpture incorporates the Homecoming theme, additional decorations, realistic looks, etc.

Donation:

- All of the collected cans and non-perishable food will be donated to Boca Helping Hands
