

### WONDERING WHAT YOU SHOULD

Submit your non-refundable \$200 tuition deposit by May 1. The sooner you commit, the sooner you can access

the housing application.

Submit your housing application by the priority deadline of March 17 at 5 p.m. Housing at Florida Atlantic is in high demand and space is LIMITED. Housing assignments are provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

Reserve your spot for **SOAR** (Student Orientation, Academics, and Resources), where you'll learn important information about academics, student services, and what it means to be an Owl.

Complete Online Advising in Owldone.

After you complete the Online Advising
Form, an Academic Advisor will contact
your FAU email address to help you with
course registration.

Validate your Residency, regardless of if you are from Florida or out-of-state.

### **SUBMIT**

official transcripts and test scores

Deadlines: Fall/Summer—August 1; Spring—October 1. Missing these deadlines may affect student enrollment, financial aid, and/or scholarship disbursement. Be sure to submit the following required documents:

- Final Official High School Transcripts sent directly from the school
- College Transcripts (dual enrollment)
- Official CLT, SAT (code: 5229) or ACT (code: 0729) scores sent directly from the testing agency
- Other Exam Credits (AP/IB/AICE)

# Exam Credits

**Submit AP/IB/AICE exam credits** to fulfill pre-requisites and begin your advanced courses early, saving time and money toward graduation!

Scores must be received by **August 1** for Summer/Fall-entering students, and **October 1** for Spring-entering students.

### **Housing and Residential Education**
