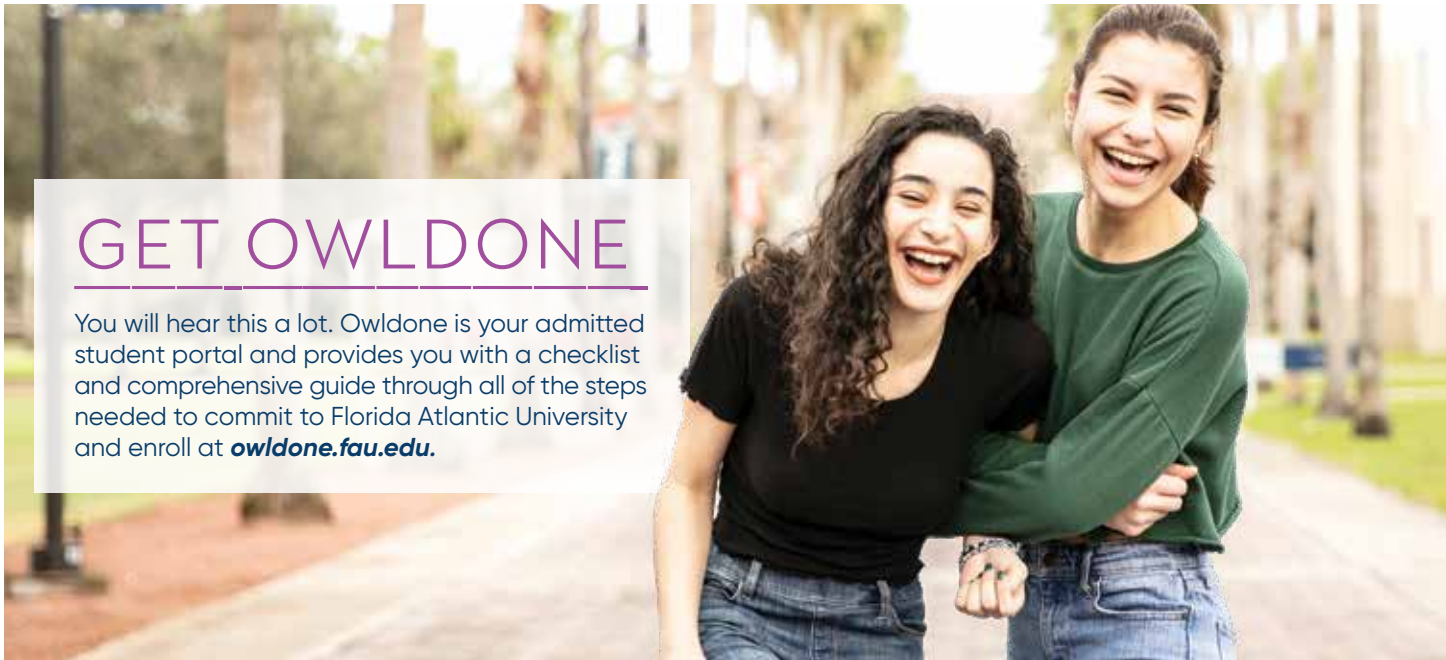

GET OWLDONE

You will hear this a lot. Owldone is your admitted student portal and provides you with a checklist and comprehensive guide through all of the steps needed to commit to Florida Atlantic University and enroll at owldone.fau.edu.

Wondering what you should do first?



Submit your non-refundable **\$200** tuition deposit by **May 1**. The sooner you commit, the sooner you will have preference to apply for on campus housing.



Submit your housing contract by the priority date of **April 1**. Housing at FAU is in **DEMAND** and space is **LIMITED**. Assignments are provided on a first-come, first-serve basis, regardless of distance from campus. Waiting until the deposit deadline is **NOT ADVISED**.



Reserve your spot for **SOAR** (Student, Orientation, Academics, and Resources) – Important information regarding academic/student services and learn what it means to be an Owl – fau.edu/orientation/firstyear



Complete **EZ Advising** – your online advising module. Can be completed once it opens in **March** after you deposit, setting you up to register for classes.



Validate your **Residency** regardless if you are from Florida or out of state.

Final Deadlines for Enrollment

You can fulfill pre-requisites and start on your advance courses, saving time and money towards graduation, when you submit AP/IB/AICE exam credits. **But failure to submit the following documents** before the term deadline may affect your enrollment as well as financial aid and/or scholarship disbursement:

Final High School Transcripts

College Transcripts (dual enrollment)

Official SAT/ACT Scores directly from the testing agency

Other Exam Credit (AP/IB/AICE)

Entry Term	Submission Deadline
Fall or Summer	August 1
Spring	October 1

Student must request and release their exam scores to FAU. Instructions on how to send official exam scores (AP/AICE/IB) can be found at www.fau.edu/admissions/examcredit.php

Summer and fall entering students' scores should be received by August 1, while Spring entering students' scores should be received by **October 1**.

Exam scores may directly impact course registration and satisfying pre-requisite course requirements.



Housing and Residential Education

At Florida Atlantic University, we offer more than just housing – we offer Residential Education! Living on campus will provide you with the convenience, connection, and support you need to thrive during your college experience.

Please note: housing space is very limited. The housing contract is a separate process that MUST be completed by each student to live on campus.

The fall 2023/spring 2024 housing contract will become available December 1st, 2022, and priority is given to completed contracts received on or before **April 1st, 2023**.
