#### 1. APPLY

Complete and submit the online application and pay the non-refundable \$30 application fee at [fau.edu/apply](https://fau.edu/apply).

#### 2. CREATE YOUR SSAR

Create your Self-reported Student Academic Record (SSAR) through your AppStatus portal at [appstatus.fau.edu](https://appstatus.fau.edu) and report your school transcripts. Please refrain from sending your transcripts directly to FAU.

#### 3. REPORT YOUR SCORE

Self report your SAT/ACT scores in your SSAR or via the AppStatus portal.

*\*Official scores are required only after receiving an admissions decision (SAT code: 5229 | ACT code: 0729).*
