Graduate research funding for scholarly research projects

Are you an active, degree-seeking graduate student (master's, doctoral, or professional) performing research? This pilot program will award Individual Research Grant Awards up to \$1,500 and Interdisciplinary Team Project Grant Awards up to \$4,000.

Eligibility and Grant Requirements

- ✓ Graduate applicants must be active, degree-seeking, and in good academic standing when applying for the GRIP Grant as well as for the duration of the project.
- Recipients may only receive one award per academic year, whether it be an individual grant or team grant award.
- ✓ Aplicants must submit a "Faculty Mentor's Letter" from a faculty sponsor.
- Award recipients must present research and inquiry projects at the Graduate and Professional Research Day event held during the spring 2016 semester.
- ✓ Progress reports must be submitted on August 1, 2015, December 1, 2015, and May 1, 2016.
- The awardee(s) must reference the GRIP Grant in any presentations and/or publications that the funds supported.
- Students are encouraged to have IRB/IACUC approval or to have an application in process prior to submitting their GRIP Grant proposal.
