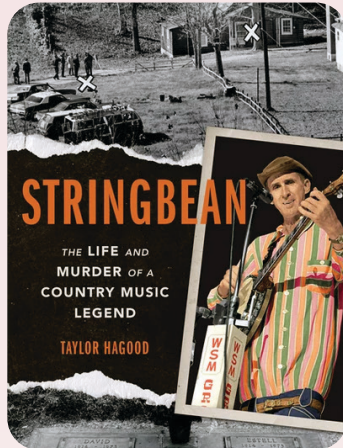

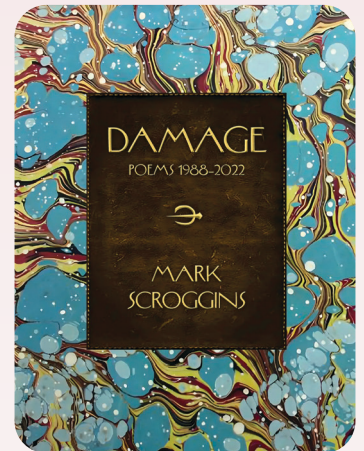
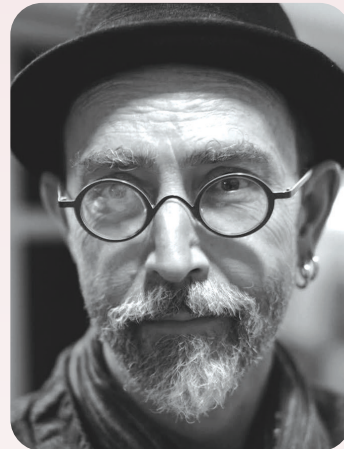


## READINGS & TALKS

He teaches American literature at FAU, with specialization in the writing of William Faulkner, African American literature, disability studies, thing studies, and the literature and culture of the United States South. Increasingly, he is exploring comparative approaches that span disciplines, such as ecocriticism, animal studies, and the Anthropocene. His books include *Secrecy, Magic, and the One-Act Plays of Harlem Renaissance Women Writers* and *Faulkner: Writer of Disability*.
