

CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN PUBLIC RECORDS MANAGEMENT

This two-day program is designed to inform and update public sector personnel about records management and maintenance under Florida law. The four half-day modules will address new technologies and management systems in the field of records management.

Module 1 focuses om the basics of records management and maintenance, including Public records law in Florida, privacy vs. right-to-know, and records retention and destruction.

Module 2 addresses file management and design and includes a historical look at File management, equipment and supplies, and information storage and retrieval systems.

Module 3 covers imaging, with particular focus on legalities and standards related to Microfilm and optical digitizing, computer retrieval systems, and cost analyses.

Module 4 discusses disaster preparedness/recovery systems and contemporary records Management issues, including off-site storage, facilities management and vital Records.

A FAU certificate of completion will be awarded to those attending all four modules.
