WHAT:

For over 20 years, *Supervision in Government* has been offered throughout Broward County to new supervisors or supervisors new to government. This unique program specifically addresses similar agency issues, workforce changes, and varying performance standards within government. Participants learn how to develop and coach staff while working within specific guidelines, policies, and collective bargaining agreements common to many public organizations. They will have an opportunity to network with other governmental supervisors and share practical ideas for managing employee performance. The series includes the following eight 3-hour modules:
