What does "Ready to Hang/Install" mean?

- Whether you are submitting sculpture, photography, mixed media, painting, drawing, graphic design, architecture models/drawings (or whatever else there are no medium requirements!) your presentation and choice of installation for your work is important and students MUST consider the presentation of their pieces BEFORE arriving to submit works.
- We highly encourage a "test hang or installation" of the works to see what will be the best solution to the piece. Any hardware other than screws – push pins, nails, t-pins, magnets, etc. must be provided with instructions on how the piece should be installed.
- Unlike previous years, we will not advocate for the installation/hanging of your pieces into the walls for the jurying process. If you are submitting an installation, please bring a photograph of what the installation looks like installed (this will require that you set the piece up prior to bringing it in).
- Video Work: Unless you bring in your own AV equipment, the video works will be screened on an iMac running Mac OS 10.7 and will accept media in the form of CD/DVD and Flash Drive.
- The gallery reserves the discretion to disqualify entries based on inadequate hanging apparatus or if no instructions/hardware are left for the pieces. While the gallery staff is willing to assist in the process of learning the correct submission process, they will not tolerate lengthy consultations on how an artwork should be displayed. The presentation of an artwork must be considered by the artist ahead of time based on the concept and/or aesthetics of the work.
