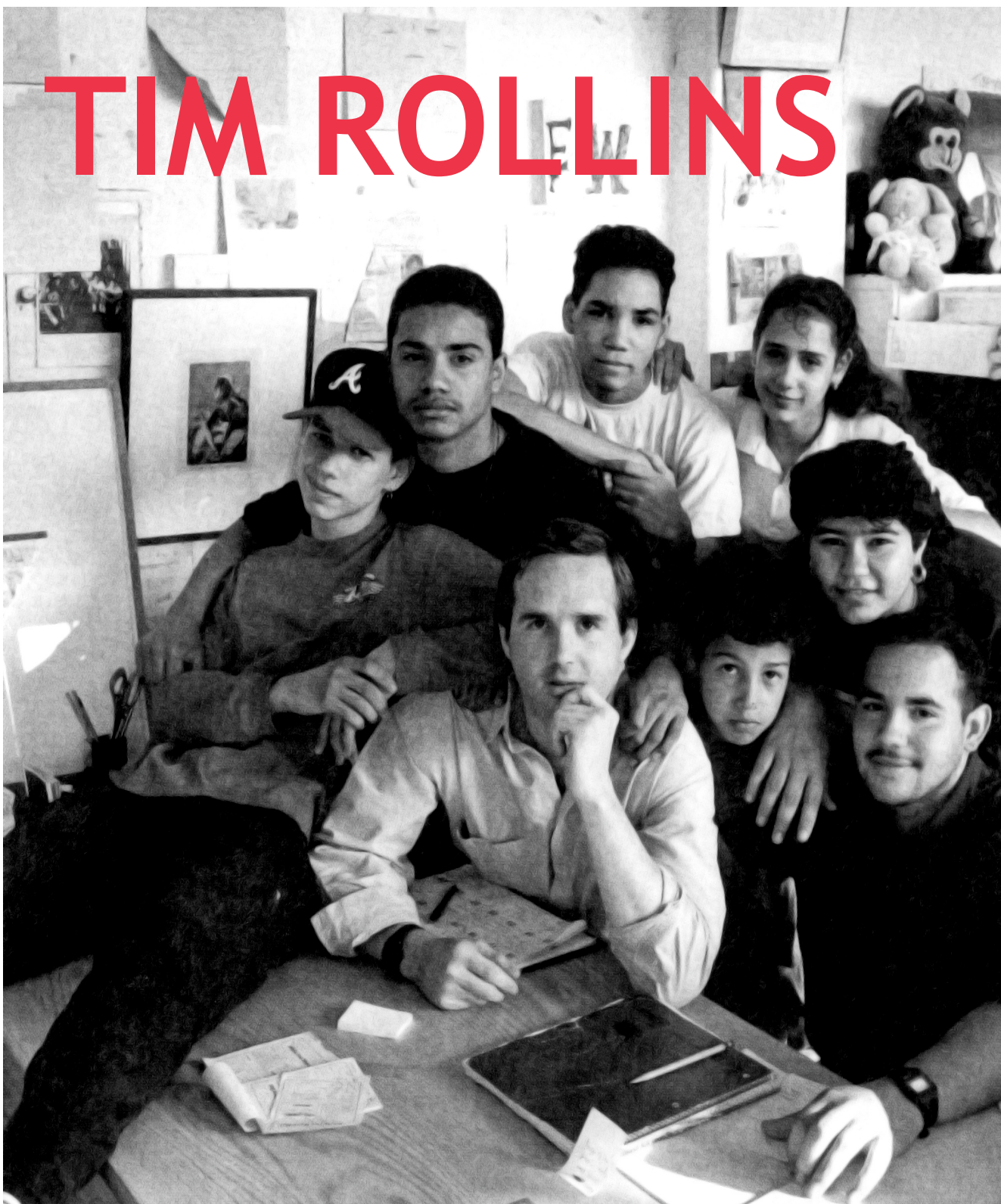

Rollins and a group of at-risk youth
from the South Bronx came together
beginning in 1984 and developed a way
of working that combined art-making
with reading classical literature and
writing personal narratives.

The group has exhibited extensively
worldwide and their work is represented
in prestigious public and private
collections including the Museum of
Modern Art, the Hirschorn Museum of
Art and the Tate Gallery London.
Spanning more than two decades, the
collaboration of Rollins and K.O.S.
continues to challenge notions of art
through their deep engagement with
literary and historical texts and
contemporary art practice.
