FLATS Application

The Foreign Language Achievement Testing Service (FLATS) is a computerized multiple-choice language examination designed by Brigham Young University (BYU) to cover the knowledge and skills that would be acquired during the first three semesters of college-level language courses. It has three testing areas: listening, reading, and formal grammar. There is no speaking portion.

Because FLATS is the exclusive property of BYU, any student who wishes to take it must pay a fee (currently \$50.00) directly to BYU via the official FLATS website <https://flats.byu.edu/signupall.php?x=8>. BYU does not release the examination until this fee is paid.

Student is given two and a half hours to complete the test.

Student is not allowed the use of any outside materials whatsoever during the test.

Student is not provided with sample test or questions.

Student passing the FLATS satisfies Florida Atlantic University Foreign Language Exit Requirement and does not receive credits.

Student failing the FLATS can retake it after six months with the proper registration and payment of fees.

When proctor receives via e-mail a registration confirmation with the information to log into the examination page, student is contacted via phone to schedule an appointment.

Student takes the examination in the testing room of the Department of Languages, Linguistics, and Comparative Literature (LLCL), which is located in the Culture and Society Building (CU 97) - room 232 and operates Monday to Friday from 8:30 to 5:00.

It takes up to two weeks for proctor to receive the official FLATS scores report via mail.

Upon reviewing the FLATS scores report by a designated LLCL faculty member, proctor notifies the Registrar's Office with the results via e-mail to update student's record.
