

## THE “IL CIRCOLO” SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDY ABROAD IN ITALY

Scholarship amount: \$ 250-\$2,000 - depending on number and qualifications of applicants.

Criteria:

- **Preferably, but not necessarily, Major** in LLCL: Italian (major must be officially declared at the time of application) or **Minor** in Italian (at a minimum students must be in the process of completing the prerequisites for the minor at the time of application);
- If an insufficient amount of Italian majors or minors apply, selection will also be made based on proven commitment to further the study of Italian language and culture at FAU and in the community.
- Min. 2.80 GPA;
- Applicants must write a min.300-word statement tracing their profile, explaining the reason for applying and articulating how funds will be used; they shall also include a statement containing a firm commitment to participate in a scholarship recognition award ceremony hosted by **Il Circolo** during the month of November;
- Deposit must be received by the office of International Programs at time of application for the programs in Venice or Orvieto.

Application deadline: March (Inquire for availability)
